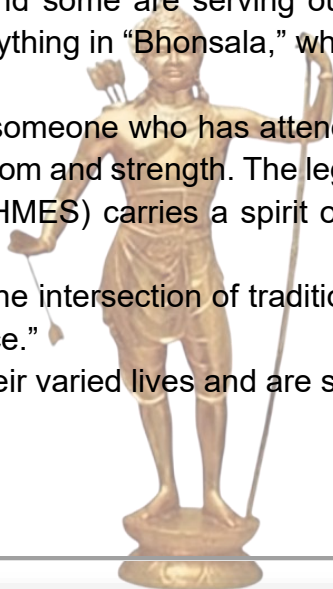

Academic Excellence and Assessments

The Second Term Examinations for Class IX were conducted from 13th March to 27th March 2026 while Class XI examinations were held from 16th March to 30th March 2026. 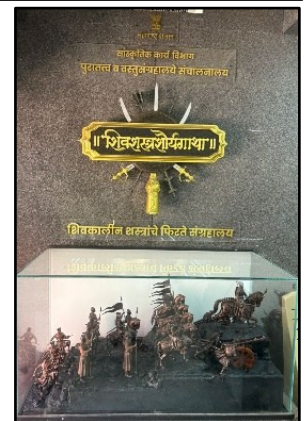


Exploring History: Shivashastrashaurayagatha – Museum on Wheels

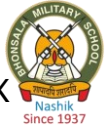


A New Beginning: Academic Session 2026–27

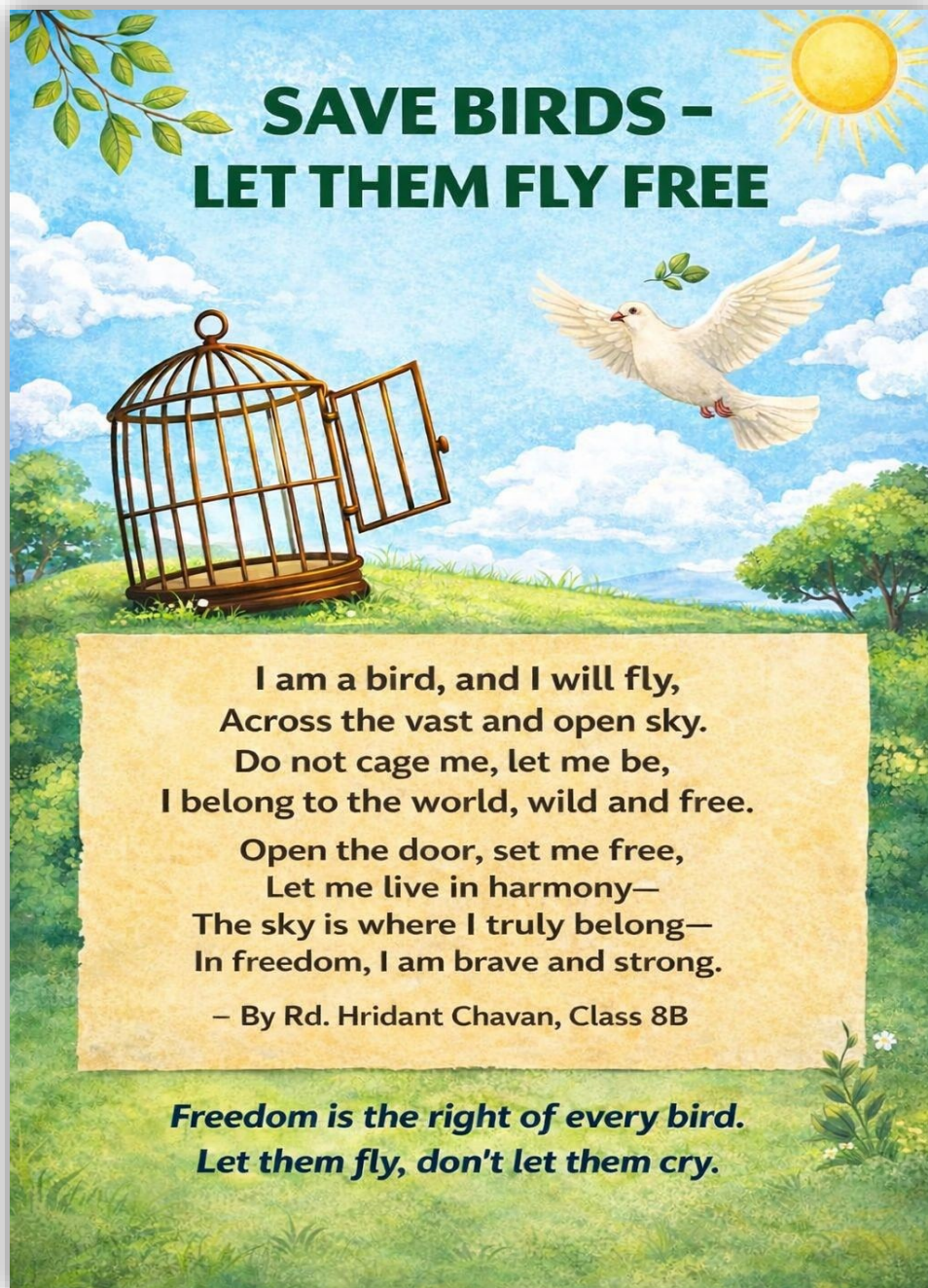
Pride of the School – Olympiad Achievement
